*A minimum of 27 dissertation credits are required to graduate. This includes a minimum of 24 dissertation credits (603) and a minimum of 3 credits of dissertation seminar (607D). Students in Years 3 and 4 of the program must be concurrently enrolled in at least 1 credit of 603 dissertation credits each term and 1 credit of 607D dissertation seminar in Fall, Winter, and Spring terms. Students who continue past year 4 must be enrolled in a minimum of 1 credit of 603 dissertation credits per term; continued enrollment in 607D credits beyond year 4 is negotiated between the student and their chair and committee as part of their approved program of study.
