## 10 Tips for a Safe Ride Every Time

3 out of 4 car seats are used incorrectly... is yours?



2 years Oregon law requires children to ride **rear facing** in a car seat until at least 2 years old.



Be sure your child meets the recommended height and weight limits of the car seat.



Oregon law requires children **under 40 pounds** to use a car seat with a harness.



Always install car seats **in the back seat** using the vehicle's seat belt or LATCH.



Fit the harness snugly so it isn't loose. You should not be able to pinch any extra harness strap at the shoulder.

Place the chest clip at armpit level, away from the neck.



The safest place for your child is in the **back seat** until at least 13 years of age.

**NEVER** place a rear-facing car seat in front of a frontal airbag.
