

Student Health and Wellness Costs of Services:

Primary Care

This chart is meant to help you understand the charges that may apply while receiving your care at the OHSU Student Health and Wellness Center (SHW). This fee schedule applies to everyone eligible for Student Health and Wellness Primary Care services: OHSU Students, post-doctoral scholars, and pathway scholars, **including their adult dependents (partners/spouses and children over 18 years)**

Behavioral Health, Wellness and Food Assistance

This chart is meant to help you understand the charges that may apply while receiving your care at the OHSU Student Health and Wellness Center (SHW). This fee schedule applies to everyone eligible for Student Health Behavioral Health, Wellness, Food Assistance and Integrative Medicine services: OHSU Students, post-doctoral scholars, and pathway scholars. **Adult dependents are not eligible for these services**, except for couples counseling when scheduled with an eligible student/post-doc/scholar.

Type of Service	Cost for all insurance types
Behavioral Health: Counseling and Therapy Groups	No cost to you. Service not billed to insurance.
Behavioral Health: Psychiatry and medication management* appointments	No cost to you for appointments. Service not billed to insurance. *Prescribed medications will be subject to your prescription drug coverage cost. For patients with HMO health insurance plans, provider may not be able to prescribe medication in the HMO network.
Behavioral Health: Couples Counseling	No cost for you or your partner. Service not billed to insurance.
Wellness: Wellness events, series, and classes	No cost to you.
Wellness: Mindfulness Coaching and Mindfulness Groups	No cost to you.
Food Assistance: Food Resource Center	No cost to you. See our website for more information.
Integrative Medicine: Massage	\$45 for 45 minutes or \$90 for 90 minutes. Self-pay and not billed to insurance. Buy One, Get One Free program: when you buy one massage, your next one will be free.
Integrative Medicine: Free Massage Program (OHSU Students only)	1 free massage during your program. Only available to OHSU students.

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OHSU Financial Assistance

By law, all hospitals have to provide financial assistance to people and families who meet certain requirements. You may be able to get free care or pay less for certain services based on your family size and income, even if you have health insurance.
