STUDENT BARRIER REMOVAL - FY25 APPLICATION

The Oregon Office of Rural Health understands there can be significant challenges associated with obtaining EMS education, and at times, these challenges can prevent a student from gaining this important education. We are pleased to announce the availability of limited funding assistance to help reduce students' barriers when they do not have other viable options for reducing the hardship.

Eligible categories include mileage and/or lodging (e.g., to attend course testing or in-person skills events), acquiring a required textbook, assistance with childcare costs during the EMS course, or assistance to access a computer for online coursework. Other forms of hardship assistance may be considered if we are provided with a detailed description and cost estimate.

Student Barrier Removal applications are reviewed and considered on a rolling basis.

Please note:

- This assistance is meant for students who are currently enrolled in EMS education courses, or who have pending awards for EMS course funding.
- It is not provided for EMS courses that were completed prior to the application date.
- It is not intended for students taking EMS prerequisite courses.
- The student (or affiliated EMS agency) must be located in a designated rural area, based on the following standardized <u>Rural Health Grants Eligibility Analyzer</u> tool: https://data.hrsa.gov/topics/rural-health/rural-health-eligibility.
