- Interactive
- Focused on critical skills



Simulation benefits:

- Self reported satisfaction from participants
- Improved team dynamics
- Focuses on adult learning styles

Simulation in rural trauma center



Peace Harbor

- Level 3 Trauma Center
- ED, MS, ICU, OR, L&D

GOALS

- High level trauma training
- Improved competence and confidence in management of critically injured patient
- Multidisciplinary

The Concept

- Use high fidelity simulation mannequin :
 - Head to toe
 - Procedures to be completed
- Team building - ED Physician, RN self selected teams
- Competitive
- Use real care location for realism (trauma bay)
- Use real supply locations



Escape the Trauma Room

- Create a significant trauma scenario with significant needs:
 - Multi system trauma
 - High risk low volume
 - Resuscitative hysterotomy
 - Airway obstruction
 - Decompression
- Hide keys that will be found during ATLS exam & trauma resuscitation
- Keys unlock critical supplies to continue resuscitation
- Escape when the patient resuscitation is complete
 - **Winner** : Best time, fewest missing elements

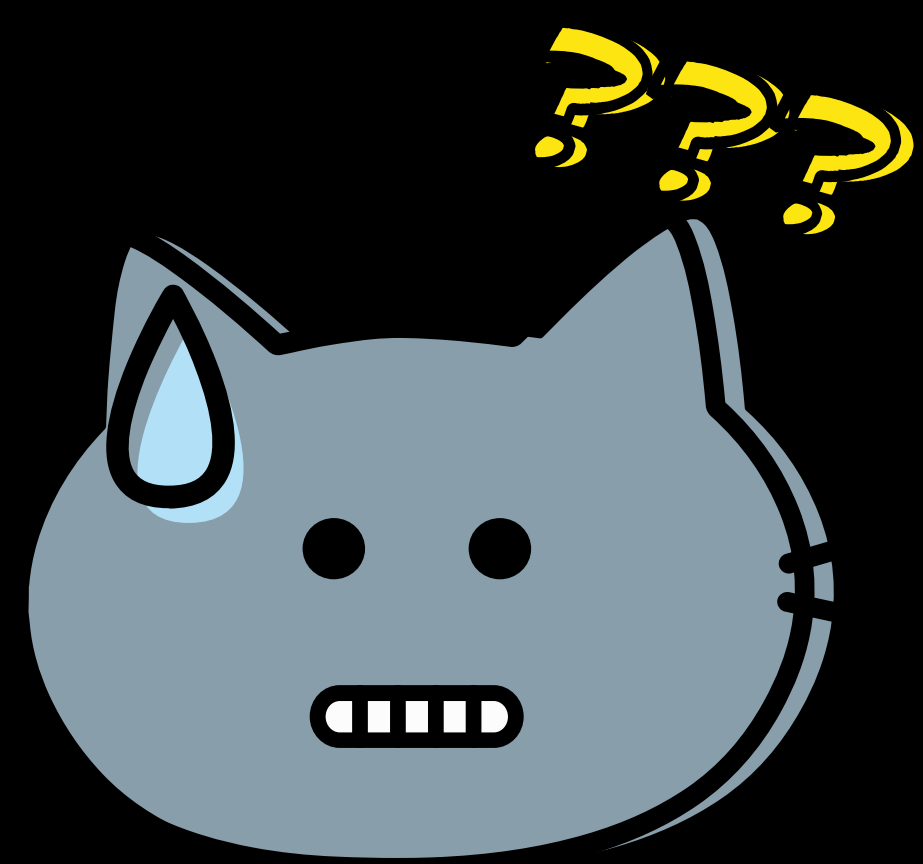
