#### What is Nitrous Oxide?

- Nitrous oxide (N<sub>2</sub>O) is a gas commonly used:
  - In medicine as a sedative and pain reliever.
  - In the food industry as a propellant for whipped cream and other culinary uses.
- Also known as: "Whippets" / "Whippits" or "Galaxy Gas"

### Recreational Misuse


- When misused recreationally, nitrous oxide can cause:
  - Euphoria or feeling "high."
  - Hallucinations or seeing or hearing things that aren't there.
- Often perceived as harmless, but repeated use can lead to:
  - Neurologic symptoms like numbness, tingling and weakness and permanent brain and nerve injury.
  - Cardiovascular issues like dangerous fluctuations in blood pressure and heart rate, blood clots, heart attack, and cardiac arrest.
  - Psychiatric effects like mood changes and severe, long-lasting conditions like psychosis.
- Inhalation outside of medical supervision is NOT safe and can result in serious injury or death.
