




# CAMPUS ACCESS *and* COMMUTE SERVICES

Oregon Health & Science University's unique transportation network connects people over river, forest, hills and neighborhoods.

- 21,016** employees
- 5,738** students
- 10** transit lines to campus
- 6,842** parking spaces
- 500** bike valet capacity
- 8** bike facilities
- 1** aerial tram

**6** out of **10** employees use an alternative to driving alone.



## Transportation network

Portland Aerial Tram is a free 5 minute ride for OHSU members and patients.  
 Tilikum Crossing is traversed by light rail, streetcars, buses, pedestrians and bikes.  
 North America's longest enclosed skybridge connects OHSU Hospital to Veterans Affairs Hospital.



# COMMUTE PROGRAMS



## Planning ahead

Custom trip plans include directions, travel time and OHSU resources for all commute options.

## Cash incentives

Members earn daily cash for biking, walking, transit and scooters.

## After hours commuting

Ride hail credits are available for late night or early morning travel.

## MyCommute

From OHSU'S online platform, employees and students earn incentives, reserve parking, join challenges, access guaranteed ride home, and follow commute news.

## Wage Based Daily Parking

Employees on payroll can purchase daily parking discounted according to their wage bracket.

## OHSU Carpool

The app matches OHSU members. Drivers earn cash. Rides are free.

## Transit

Light rail, streetcar and bus all service campus. Transit passes are heavily discounted. Streetcar and aerial tram are free with an OHSU badge.

## Bikes and scooters

Bikes and e-bikes are free to borrow up to 30 days. Cash vouchers are available to purchase a bike. Go By Bike provides onsite repair and free valet. Several OHSU badge-access facilities include showers, lockers and towel service. Campus pedicab is free.

## Walk

People walk to and around OHSU via car-free bridges, multi-use paths, trails through Marquam Nature Park and North America's longest enclosed sky bridge.

## Remote work

OHSU supports remote work with 4 out of 10 OHSU employees primarily off site.
