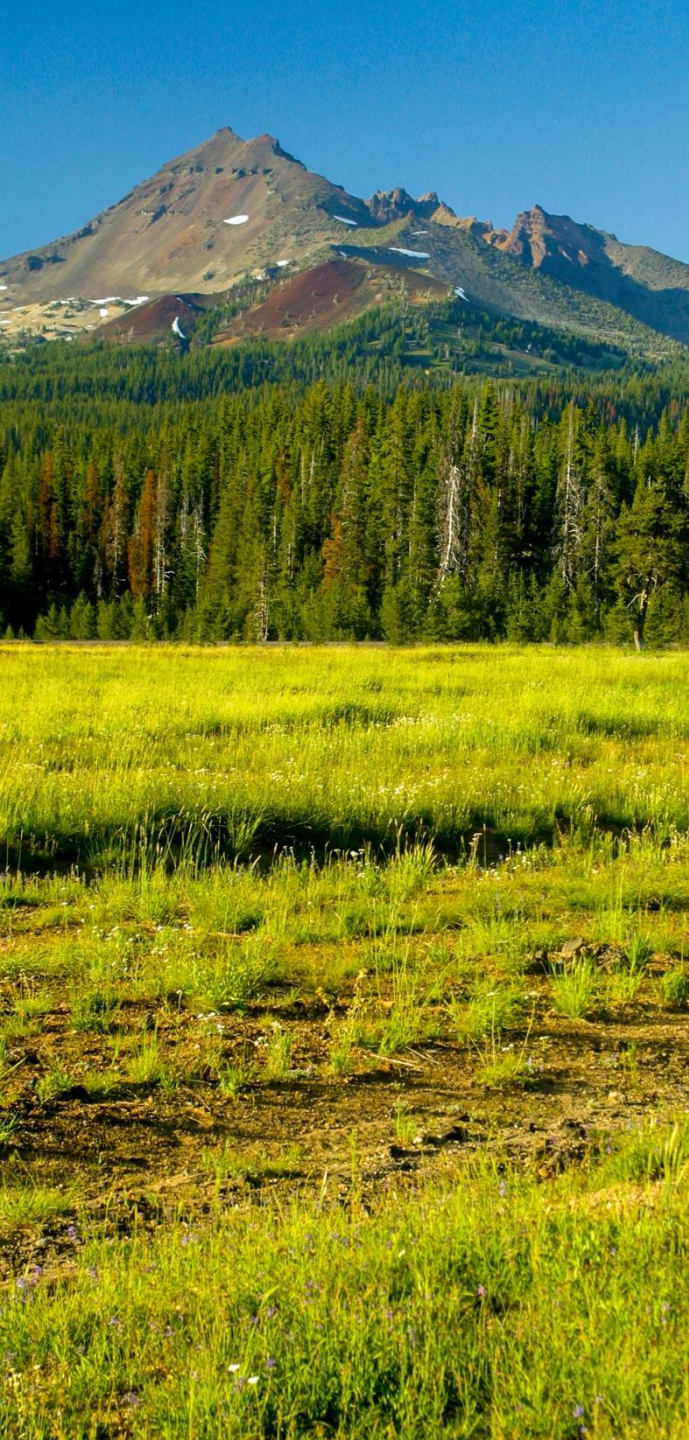
## Project Purpose and Goals

- Support grant applications to OHA RHTP program and other funders

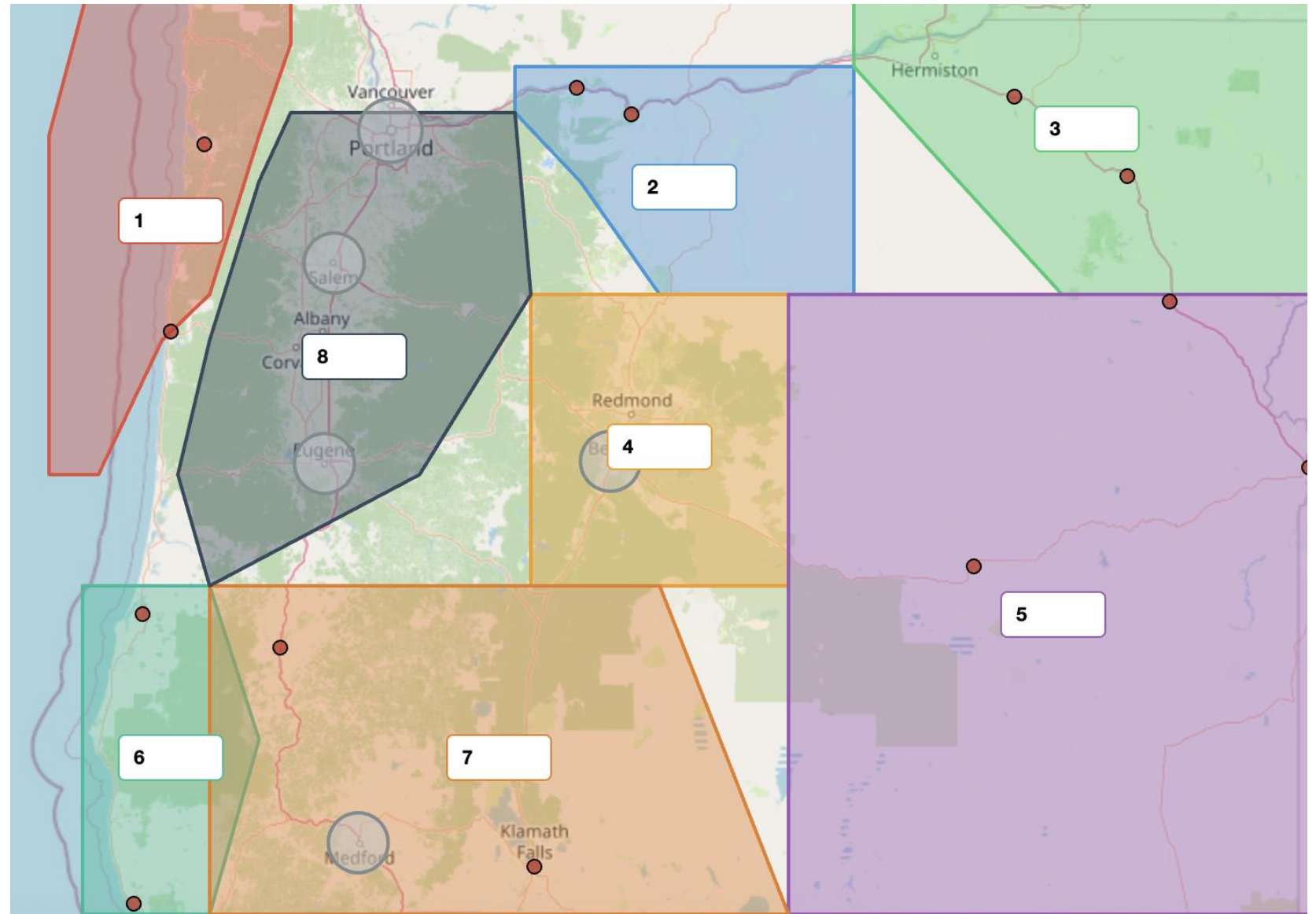


## Approach

- Regional convenings
  - Year 1: One in-person meeting per region (eight total)
  - Year 2: Four in-person meetings per region (32 total)
  - Interspersed virtual meetings
- Statewide convening in conjunction with ORH Conference
  - Oct. 7-9, 2026 in Bend (RHTP gathering on Oct. 9)
  - Includes vendor fair
- Targeted technical assistance (provided by both ORH and trusted experts) focused on (but not limited to):
  - Finances
  - Operations
  - IT
  - Strategic planning
  - Grant writing and management
    - Sustainability
    - Identifying and tracking outputs and outcomes
  - Learning collaboratives
