

Forensic Psychiatry

A new page under Documents called “Specialty Documents” will be added for Fellowship applicants so that they can upload documents required by specific specialties. For the first year, the only specialty will be Forensic Psychiatry. Documents will be automatically assigned to all of the forensic psychiatry programs that an applicant applies to.

If the applicant has not sent application to any programs yet, they will have the option to Replace that document. After applicant applies to a program, they will no longer have the option to replace their uploaded document.

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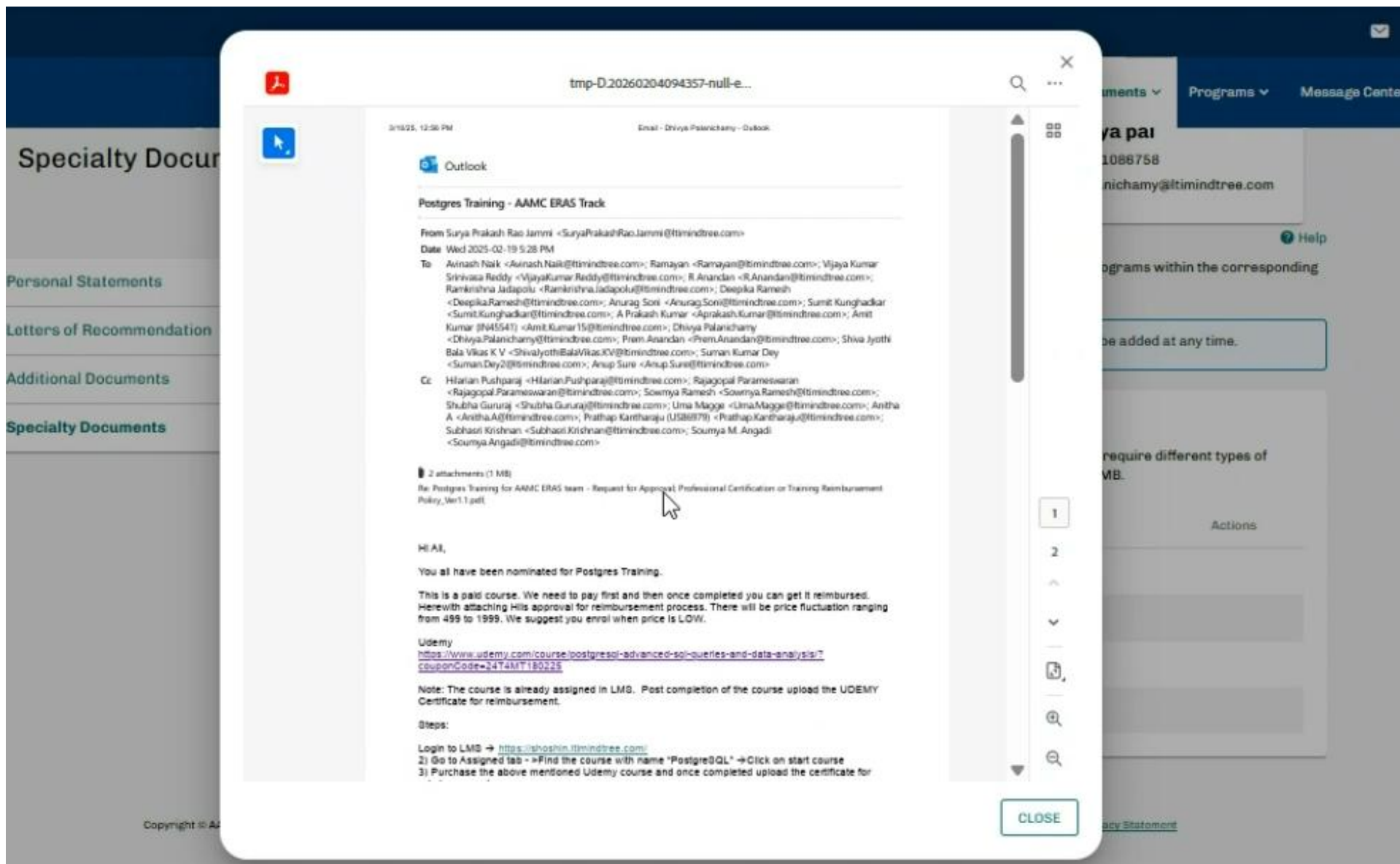

Previewing an Uploaded Document

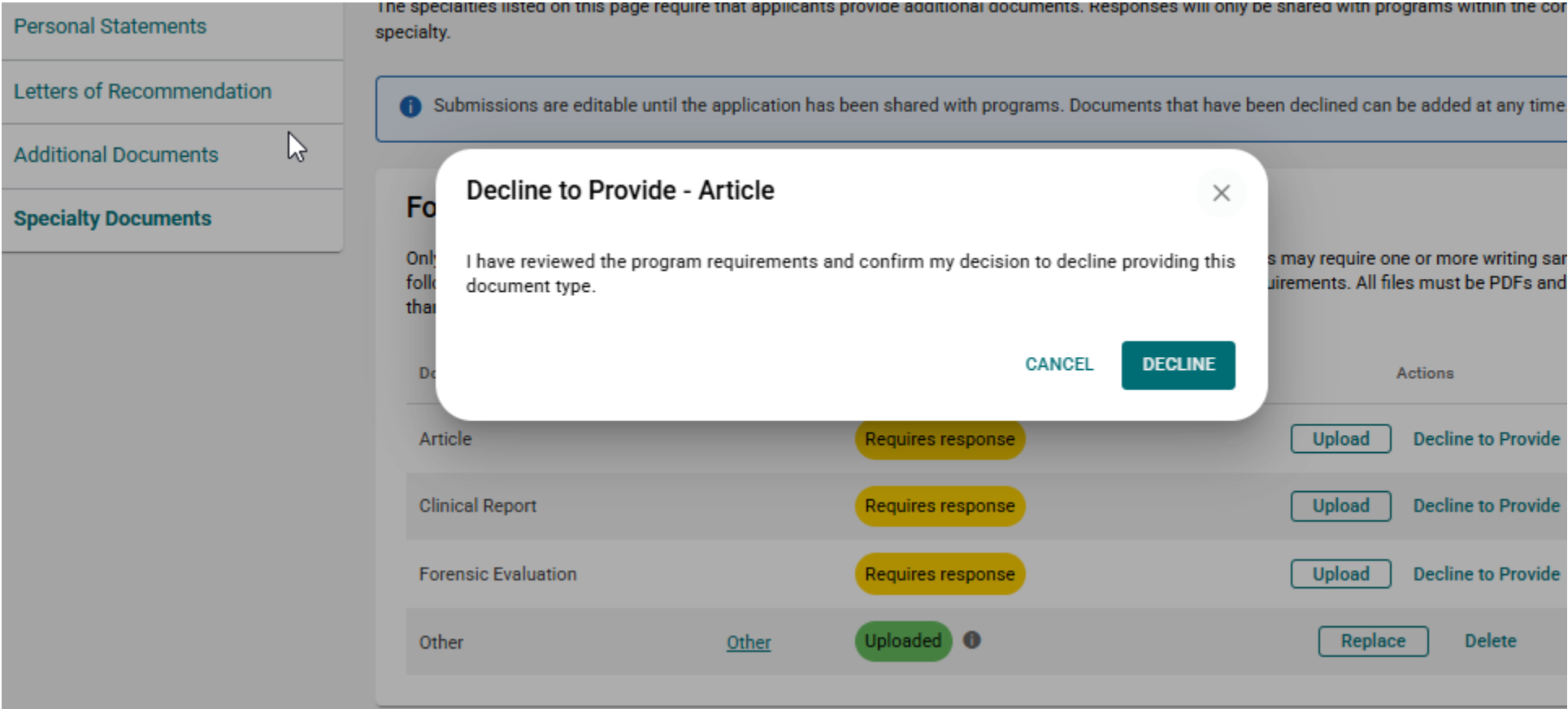
When applicants click a link in the File column, they will see a PDF preview of the document they uploaded.



Declining to Provide

They will have the option to Decline to Provide a document.

They will also be prompted to provide confirmation when declining to provide a specific document type:

Incomplete Response Reminder (Saved Programs)

Applicants who save forensic psychiatry programs (and have not **responded to all four prompts** requesting additional documentation) will be prompted on the Saved Programs page to provide that information and will be blocked from applying until they respond to the request (even if they “Decline to Provide” all documentation).

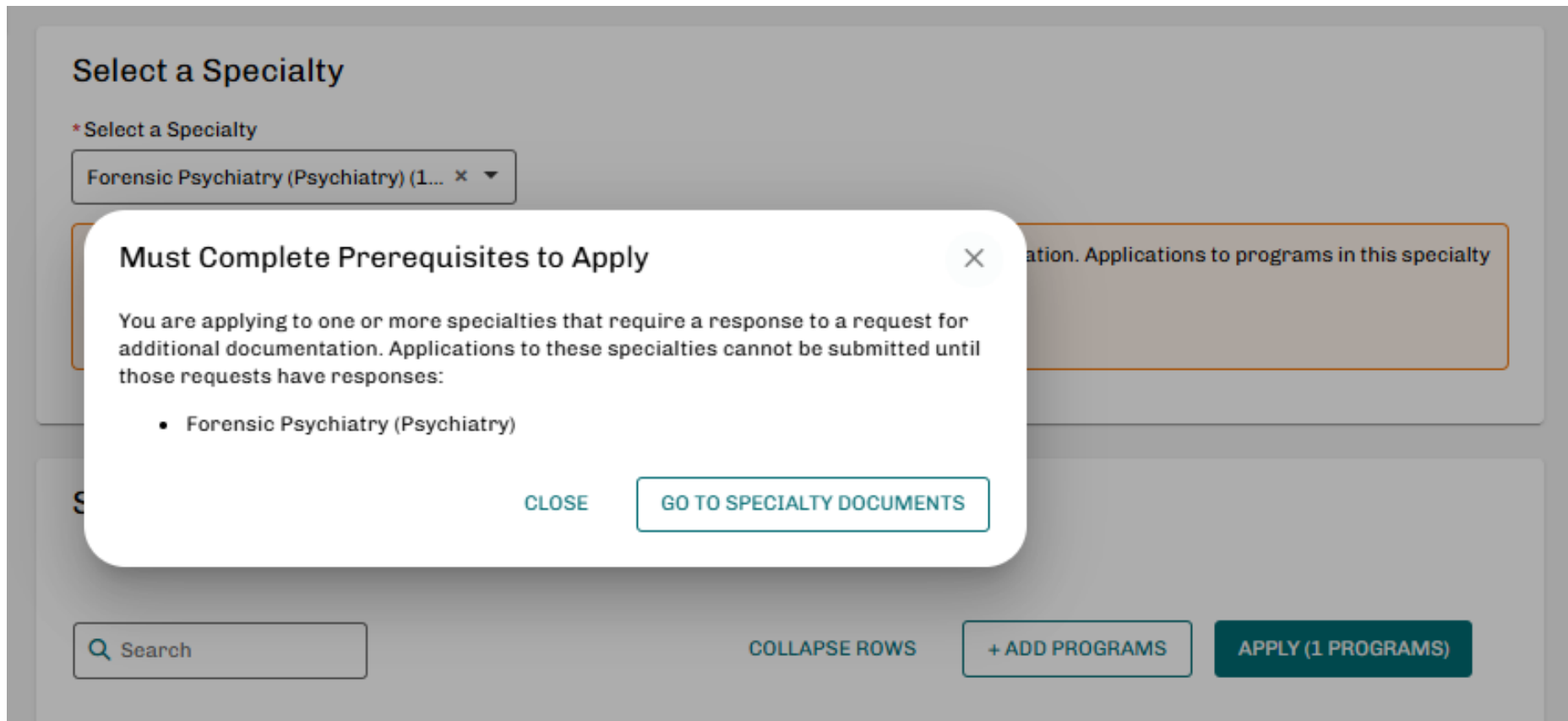

Required Response Reminder (When Trying to Apply)

If an applicant attempts to apply to a Forensic Psychiatry program before they have responded to the request for additional documentation, they will see a warning modal explaining that they must respond to the prompts before applying to that specialty.
