What Is Technical Assistance?

Technical assistance is hands-on expert help, matched to whatever your organization or region is trying to figure out. It is delivered by Oregon Office of Rural Health (ORH) staff and a bank of contracted partners with deep experience in rural health finance, quality, workforce, data and systems design at no cost to you. **TA is scoped to your needs, not to a fixed package:** a two-hour conversation, a written feasibility analysis, a facilitated regional planning session or coaching that continues for months. You do not need a funding award, a finished plan, or even a fully formed idea to reach out, feel free to just connect for help.

Why Organizations Reach Out

The Goal: Ready Communities, Strong Proposals

At the end of Year 2, the Oregon Health Authority will open a funding opportunity for regional rural health projects. This TA program aims to ensure that when that moment arrives, your region is not starting from scratch. Between now and then, TA can help you test whether an idea is viable, build the partnerships a competitive regional proposal requires, gather the data that makes your case, strengthen your operations and quality of care and sharpen the application itself.

The work you do now is what makes a strong proposal possible later. Regions that use this year to build relationships and do the groundwork will be far better positioned than those that wait.

How to Request TA
