Stop the Bleed Instructor Volunteer Position

The OHSU Adult Trauma Injury Prevention Program teaches ACS Stop the Bleed to our community and we need your help to provide this valuable resource as an instructor or assistant instructor. We do not charge participants for the training. We teach participants how to identify life threatening bleeding, how to respond to the emergency, and bleeding control techniques, including the use of a tourniquet.

Courses are one hour long and include a lecture and hands-on skills training. The OHSU Adult Trauma Program provides all training materials for the courses and coordinates all the courses.
