Introductions of all participants & attendees

Approval of August minutes

Dana Director is taking over Bob Vieira's (Vice Provost for Student Affairs) position. He retired from OHSU in June 2013. Dana's title is Vice President for Research Operations and Student Affairs.

No funding requests were received this month.

A proposal to change the Web Coordinator stipend to \$1000 from \$500 was made. Discussion occurred on that topic. What are the roles of Web Coordinator position? Duties include: managing blog site and Face Book account, working with Communication Specialist in Provost's Office to provide input on student portal website, and helping plan social events with other VPs.
