<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Cognition:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Memory, awareness of deficits, speed of information processing, attention, executive functioning</li></ul></li><li>● Verbal communication:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Articulation, low volume, thought organization, word finding, rate and fluency of speech</li></ul></li><li>● Auditory and written comprehension</li><li>● Written expression</li><li>● Social communication</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Independence in activities of daily living:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Bathing, dressing, eating</li></ul></li><li>● Decreased coordination or strength</li><li>● Executive function disturbance:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Planning/ Organization, initiation, problem-solving</li></ul></li><li>● Altered visual processing and perception</li><li>● Equipment needs to improve daily living</li><li>● Fatigue</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Independence in mobility:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Transfers, bed mobility, ambulation</li></ul></li><li>● Altered:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Strength, ROM, coordination</li></ul></li><li>● Balance:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Fall risk, dizziness, vestibular dysfunction</li></ul></li><li>● Pain</li><li>● Equipment needs to improve mobility</li><li>● Fatigue</li></ul>

Patients, families and physicians will be provided recommendations on: type, frequency and duration of therapies needed to improve functional outcomes, equipment needs and referrals to community providers (ie: vocational rehabilitation, support groups, orthotics or other medical equipment)

### Target Patient Populations:

- Brain Injury (Mild, Traumatic, Anoxic), Movement disorders (including Parkinson's disease), Multiple Sclerosis, Muscular Dystrophies, Subarachnoid hemorrhage, Stroke, Tumor resection
