Dear Parent/Guardian:

Thank you for considering referral to the Community Connections Network for your child. This can be a very beneficial experience for you and your family.

I would like to take a few moments of your time to explain the program. The Community Connections Network is a group of community members who are familiar with services available in our area for children and families. The team consists of members from health care, mental health, education and social services. We are a group that tries to represent all the available services that may be available to your child. Team members have many years of experience working in the local area with children and families. All services during the clinic are confidential. To create the best clinic for your child, we also invite your child's doctor, teacher and any other providers to attend based on a list you provide in the referral packet.

The clinic consists of a visit with one of our team doctors the week before the team meeting. At this visit your child will receive a comprehensive childhood exam at no cost to you. At the time of the team meeting, you may bring along anyone you feel is important to the care of your child.

You will have the opportunity to ask questions and to hear recommendations. We are here to serve the needs of the child, and your personal concerns for him/her will always be top priority.
